## 2 Vortospecoj (Parts of Speech)

7. Adverbs: Most adverbs end in -e.

e.g. bone (well), bele (beautifully), interese (interestingly)

There are many adverbs that stand on their own, and we will see them, but they don't often agglutinate so we will slowly learn them.

8. The accusative: Direct objects are indicated with an "n" ending. This is very important, as it serves to identify the direct object as against the indirect object.
